In December 2012 the microbudget feature film LIFE JUST IS was released in cinemas and on DVD/VOD. But how did the film get made? Find out all this and more at this special event!

Throughout the entire process of making LIFE JUST IS, the film's cast and crew have striven to be open about the journey they were on, posting a number of detailed blogs, vlogs and articles online. Now the film has been released, writer/director Alex Barrett is taking this openness one stage further by publishing two books: a Director's Journal, featuring an edited version of the journal he kept throughout the seven years of the film's creation, and a Scriptbook featuring both the final and very first drafts of the script.

Once the Q&A is over, we'll be encouraging everyone to hang around, have a drink, and do some networking!

As well as the intro, screening, Q&A and networking, there will also be a raffle to win a poster signed by the cast (free for ticket holders and book purchasers) and a special offer on the price of the books.
