Rolling Call for Entries

Show your shorts and pitch new projects!

Life's Just Networking is a networking event with a difference. Combining short film screenings, filmmaker presentations and hosted networking, the event is designed to get filmmakers connected and collaborating.

But in order to make it work, we need your films and we need your presentations! Broken into four parts, the evening consists of casual networking, short film screenings (followed by Q/As with attending filmmakers), presentations from filmmakers about their new projects and finally more networking. The evening runs as follows:

19:00-20:00: Networking

20:00-21:00: Short films + Q/As with the attending filmmakers

21:00-21:15: Break/Networking

21:15-22:00: Filmmaker Presentations

22:00-23:00: Networking

The evening has been designed to maximise the effectiveness of the networking: the shorts allow people to get a sense of your work and see if they think they might be suited to your style, while the presentations allow you to talk about your upcoming projects and say what you need to realise them, giving others an opportunity to find out more and get involved.

'Filmmaker' is used as a general term, and people from all areas of production – from actors to directors to producers to grips to composers – are welcome to screen their work and/or discuss new projects: Perhaps you are a writer looking for a director? Or a director looking for a cinematographer? Or a cinematographer looking for a focus puller? Whatever it is you do and whatever it is you need, come and talk to the crowd about yourself and your work!

The event runs on the second Tuesday of every month at The Duchess, Battersea. If you are interested in having a short film screened at the event, or discussing one of your upcoming projects, please email us with a brief synopsis (up to fifty words) of the film/project on events@lifejustisfilm.com, along with any other relevant information (if submitting a film, please also include a still). We would especially like to hear from people who are interested in both screening a previous film and presenting their next, though attendance is not essential for getting your work screened. As this is a rolling submission there is no deadline, though please note that we typically finish the programme for a particular event around one month before it happens.
